

Topic - Electricity

This has involved us in making posters detailing the dangers of electricity and posters showing the different ways of making electricity. We have had fun learning how to make a light bulb work, motor go and a switch work in our circuit making activities.



Maths - Symmetry and Shape

We undertook many activities to help us learn about symmetry. These ranged from a symmetry hunt in and around the school to painting butterflies and creating 3D symmetrical constructions. We then moved on to look at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and tried our hand at making some of these 3D shapes using the Clix construction.

Language

We've taken characters from stories and made up a whole new adventure for them. Our favourite story has been "Room on the Broom" by Julia Donaldson. We also watched the DVD of the same story. This provided us with an opportunity to carry out some MIE work looking at sound as well as doing a comparison between the book and the film.
