Here are some ideas for the P1-3 class to do.

<p>P2/3</p>   <p>Write an acrostic poem for the word SNOW or SNOWMAN. Remember, the word is written down the side, one letter under the other. Each line begins with a word starting with S, N, etc. and the poem is to be about what snow is like or about building a snowman.</p>	<p>P2/3</p>  <p>Draw the different stages you take to make a snowman. Try to do it in 6 steps. Write a sentence underneath each one, detailing what is happening.</p>	<p>P1</p>  <p>Draw or paint your ideal snowman.</p>	<p>All</p> <p>Make paper snowflakes from folding a circle.</p> 
<p>ALL</p> <p>Make a paper chain of snowmen. Decorate each one.</p> 	<p>All</p> <p>If you are out in the snow, have your picture taken. Use this to write about what you did. Primary 1's can get an adult to scribe.</p> 	<p>P2/3</p> <p>How many winter words can you think of?</p> <p>snow</p> <p>cold</p> <p>ice.....</p>	<p>P1</p> <p>How many words can you think of that begin with the letter "s"?</p> <p>Santa</p> <p>snow</p> <p>sun.....</p>
